2. Call for Proposals: Submit a proposal and share your experience and insights

On the third half day, September 3, 2020 (3pm CEST*), the focus is "Research on Education Leadership around the World". A variety of short research based presentations on Education Leadership / School Leadership around the world are provided. Various discussion forums will be organized, including group discussions. Submissions are welcome in the format of 5 to 10-minute presentations. Presentations are expected to report summaries of research or development projects or to provide a brief reflection on a current topic of research on education leadership and management.

Submissions as to the topics of the first half day "COVID-19 - Crises in Society and Impact on Education around the World" or the second half day "Practices of Education Leadership around the World" are also possible and appreciated.

Submission of proposals is possible till August 17, 2020.

Presentations already accepted by a conference in 2020/2021, which was cancelled recently due to the consequences of the corona crises, **will be automatically accepted** without any further review for WELSONline.
